The exhibition space includes three galleries that can accommodate both 2D and 3D art, as well as bins for additional 2D works.

Notification of Acceptance: Saturday, January 11, 2025  
Drop-off date: January 23–25 from 9:00am – 2:00pm  
Show Opening: Tuesday, January 28  
“Meet and Greet”: Saturday, February 15  
Show Closing: Sunday, March 23, 2025

**Display Fee.** For those selected for the show, there is a display fee to help cover advertising, printing, use of space, and other costs associated with hosting the display: \$30 for Takoma ARTery Members, \$40 for non-members.

### Artwork Requirements

- Hanging 2D work must have a hanging wire and be in a frame or have finished edges, and be no more than 30 inches wide. Works larger than 30 inches wide will be considered only if space allows.
- Works in bins must be 2D, matted, and have protective wrapping
- A limited number of 3D work may be displayed in the gallery's large case (contains moveable shelves)
- All works must have a label on the back with artist's name, contact info, title, medium, dimensions, and price
